# 9 GENERAL BUSINESS

General business discussed regarding council matters.

Initiative to get the SWTCC to be a clerk of course at one of our events and invitations to SWTCC members with discounted entry.

A thankyou was made to Chris Williams for being clerk of course for three events in 2010. Without him those events would not have run.

Discussion regarding the off road buggies utilising our tracks. Interest has come from the Rock Crawling Association and the Action RV Centre.

### 9.1 Autocross

Tyre strapping was almost completed, but sand filling needed to be done. There were still some technical aspects including runoffs and pits area to be defined. Once completed the track can be examined and approved for use. Consideration given to Khanacross track test 4 as the tip my be set to expand moving into that area.

# 9.2 Entries

Entries are to be continued to be limited to 40.



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#### 9.3 Calendar for 2010

The 2011 calendar dates was set. The 1<sup>st</sup> BORMSA event date of 2011 will be a Khanacross on April 2nd. The last event date will be a Khanacross on October 30<sup>th</sup>. A total of 5 Khanacrosses and 4 Autocrosses (the first being club invitational only) were proposed, but it was noted that they would only run if officials were available to run them. The website to be updated accordingly will all proposed event dates.

### 9.4 Fees

### 9.6 Club Championship

Decision made to leave points structure the same as 2010. Trophies will be for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> outright, 1<sup>st</sup> Ladies, 1<sup>st</sup> Junior and 1<sup>st</sup> Autocross.

Other business noted was a thankyou to the Bruinsmas for the donation of the toilet ablution block. A general thankyou to all who have assisted with machinery and supplies.
