Priority: If the number of entries exceeds the maximum
number of entries, first priority of acceptance will
be given to members BORMSA, and then in
order of received, fully paid entries. A maximum
of three entries per vehicle will be accepted.

Eligibility: Entrant and Driver must be a member of a CAMS affiliated Car Club,
and current Club Membership Cards must be produced at
documentation. Entrant and Driver must hold and produce a valid
2NSJ (or higher) CAMS Licence at documentation. The minimum age
for drivers is 14. Drivers between the ages of 14 to 16 years must
have previously competed in motorkhanas. Juniors (14 – 18 yrs) must
have their entry form signed by their parent or their legal guardian.
Drivers can only compete in one vehicle.

Scrutiny/Documentation:

The vehicle must pass scrutiny and comply with Group 4H and Section 6, Schedule A (Refer also Schedule J, where applicable) as per the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. A fire extinguisher of at least 900g complying with Schedule H of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport must be fitted.

Scrutiny and documentation will be conducted on Sunday 17th June 2007 at BORMSA Motorplex, commencing at 8.30am and finishing at 9.40am.

Tests:

8 to 24 tests may be conducted, with up to 4 tests running concurrently. After all competitors have completed the first 4 tests, the courses will be changed to the next 4. This procedure will be repeated until the event concludes.

Safety:

All drivers shall, while competing, wear at least a lap/sash type seat belt. (Unless exempted by registration with CAMS as an Historic Car). All competitors must wear a helmet complying with AS 1698 or a Standard listed in Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Goggles or a helmet with visor (AS1609-1981) must be worn in all open cars and in closed cars which have no windscreen.

Apparel:

Neck to wrist to ankle, fire retardant clothing must be worn. Suitable and appropriate footwear must be worn – Footwear which has a leather upper and worn with pure cotton or pure woollen socks is okay. Footwear made of synthetic material, thongs, roman sandals and high heels are not suitable or appropriate.
