SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS..BORMSA MOTORKHANA 26th August 2007

Eligibility:

Entrant and Driver must be a member of a CAMS affiliated Car Club. Current Club Membership Cards must be produced at documentation. Entrant and Driver must possess and produce a 2NSJ (or higher) CAMS Licence at documentation. And must be over the age of 12. Juniors (12 – 18 yrs) must have their entry form signed by their parent or their legal guardian. Drivers can only compete in one vehicle.

Scrutiny/Documentation:

The vehicle must pass scrutiny and comply with Schedule A and with Group H Regulations as per the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Scrutineering and documentation will be conducted on Sunday 26th August 2007 at BORMSA Motorplex commencing at 8.30am Finishing at 9.40am.

Safety:

All drivers shall, while competing, wear at least a lap/sash type seat belt. (Unless exempted by registration with CAMS as an Historic Car). Drivers of motorkhana specials and open vehicles must wear a helmet complying with AS 1698 or Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motorsport. Goggles or a helmet with visor (AS1609-1981) must be worn in all open cars and in closed cars which have the windscreen removed.

Apparel:

Neck to wrist to ankle, fire retardant clothing must be worn.

Suitable and appropriate footwear must be worn — Footwear which has a leather upper and worn with pure cotton or pure woollen socks is okay. Footwear made of synthetic material, thongs, roman sandals and high heels are not suitable or appropriate.
